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Program Spotlights: Peachy Plates Initiative

Launched to combat food insecurity and support chronic condition management, the Peachy Plates program delivered 300 grocery packages to individuals across New York and the Caribbean. Each package was designed to align with nutrition needs for those managing PCOS, Endometriosis, and Adenomyosis.

Our PeachyInstaCart volunteers not only delivered groceries but also offered meaningful connections, conversation, and emotional support to participants experiencing isolation and health challenges.

Peach Cares: Peachy Positive Care Packs

Peach Cares was created to address the critical yet often overlooked issue of menstrual equity. In 2024, we delivered Peachy Positive Care Packs to 28 menstruators, including both adolescents in community-based schools and adults in our wellness programs.

Each pack included:

- Menstrual hygiene products
- Toiletries and personal care essentials
- Positive affirmation cards
- Resources for reproductive wellness

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Peachy Glow Makeover Initiative

Our Peachy Glow Makeover Initiative was created to restore confidence in individuals navigating chronic health issues that often impact self-image. In 2024, we hosted two makeover events where participants received:

- Professional hair and makeup styling
- New outfits for job interviews, wellness events, or self-celebration
- Mental health affirmations and empowerment talks
